



Master of Education in Curriculum and Instruction

Off-Campus Cohorts for Members of the Pittsburgh Federation of Teachers

The Pittsburgh Federation of Teachers and Gannon University have partnered to offer teachers and educational professionals in the Pittsburgh School District a Master of Education in Curriculum and Instruction. The program will be offered in its entirety in the Greater Pittsburgh Area.

- The Gannon M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction is a 37 credit, non-thesis portfolio-based program.
- The Gannon core curriculum of 24 credits is taken over 18 – 24 months.
- Twelve credits earned from the Pittsburgh Federation of Teachers' Educational Research and Dissemination Program will be used as electives.
- The one-credit Portfolio requirement will consist of the graduate student completing and presenting a portfolio that highlights standards from each core course.
- Tuition is \$425.00 per credit for any cohort starting in Summer 2007 and \$455 per credit for any cohort beginning in the 2007-2008 Academic Year. The tuition rate is guaranteed for the length of the cohort.
- This program is only for members of the Pittsburgh Federation of Teachers.

Saturday and Summer Option

- ◆ Core courses meet every other Saturday during the academic year and during two one-week sessions in the summer. Elective courses may be taken at your convenience. The cohort will begin in Fall 2007 (minimum enrollment required).

Summer and On-line Option

- ◆ The eight core courses meet during three one-week sessions in the Summer 2007 and Summer 2008 semesters. One on-line course is taken during Fall 2007 and another in Spring 2008 (minimum enrollment required). **We must have the minimum enrollment required by Friday, May 18, 2007 in order to begin the cohort in June.** We will continue to process applications after that date on a space available basis.
