### **Off-Campus Cohort for Members of the Pittsburgh Federation of Teachers**

#### **The Spring Semester Begins on Saturday, January 20, 2007\***

The Pittsburgh Federation of Teachers and Gannon University have partnered to offer teachers and educational professionals in the Pittsburgh School District a Master of Education in Curriculum and Instruction. The program will be offered in its entirety in the Greater Pittsburgh Area.

- The Gannon M.Ed. in Curriculum and Instruction is a 37 credit, non-thesis portfolio-based program.
- The Gannon core curriculum of 24 credits is taken over 18 months.
- Classes meet every other Saturday during the academic year and during two one-week sessions in the summer.
- Twelve credits earned from the Pittsburgh Federation of Teachers' Educational Research and Dissemination Program will be used as electives.
- The one-credit Portfolio requirement will consist of the graduate student completing and presenting a portfolio that highlights standards from each core course.
- Tuition is \$425.00 per credit for any cohort starting in the 2006-2007 Academic Year. The tuition rate is guaranteed for the length of the cohort.
- Classes will be held at the Boyce Campus of CCAC in Monroeville.
- This program is only for members of the Pittsburgh Federation of Teachers.
- **Minimum enrollment must be met by December 20 in order to begin the program on January 20.\***
